**2. MATTERS ARISING**

Yellow Lines - Claythorne Order Yellow Lines - ongoing. Caroline to write letter checking on the lines at the bottom of Cleveden Road/Dorchester Place and if the lines on Chelmsford Avenue are to go ahead.

Litter Bins - Moira said that the bins still hadn't been put in Leicester Avenue. Caroline to check on this and also bins for Stonefield Ave./Baronald Gate
