**MINUTES OF LAST MEETING**

**MATTERS ARISING:**

**Yellow lines** outside the Church should be painted soon. Moira asked if lines would be put at the corner of SPAR on Cleveden Road and on Dorchester Avenue at the junction with Cleveden Road - Cllr Rhodes will look into this, however Cllr. Letford said he thought there were not more plans for yellow lines at the moment.

**Litter Bins** have been approved for Leicester, Weymouth, Ashburton, Winchester as well as Kelvindale and Cleveden Roads and should be put in soon. New covers have also been approved for the Notice Boards.

**COUNCILLORS' REPORT:**

Cllr. Rhodes - action on the yellow lines, parking and mechanical cleaning of local roads. Old style bins for Dorchester Avenue cannot be replaced by wheelie bins. 20's Plenty sign needs to be fixed again. Snow Warden names needed (Caroline and Wendy?). Kelvin Walkway bins now emptied and will be checked regularly.

Cllr. Letford - submitted a written report (attached) covering parking, yellow lines, Kelvindale Primary, Cancer Information, Community Care Alarms and the Affordable Warmth Scheme.

Cllr Scally - action on mechanical sweeping of local roads and street lights not working. Reported flooding at Dorchester and Rippon.

**PLAY PARK :**

Nick reported that a Working Group with aims and objectives had been formed for the development of the Weymouth/Dorchester Playpark. At the moment there is £19,960 set aside for the park however, the Working Group is hopeful to increase this figure with funding from other sources. Parents and kids have been asked what they would like and a meeting has been arranged with Brian Burns and the designer at the site to discuss options (Tuesday, 4th December 2012 at 2pm).

## **REPORT FROM THE CHAIR :**

Cleveden Head Teacher Roger Boyle had alerted Caroline to the problem with litter coming from school children. The School has been made aware of the problem and senior management do lunchtime patrols trying to identify culprits. Polystyrene cartons from the local food outlets are the main problem and Caroline will bring this up at the Area Committee .PC Glancy is also helping to try and identify the culprits. The Community Police will attend at lunchtime and give assistance.. Catherine Trainer said that she had come to the meeting to discuss this issue and that Health and Safety is becoming an issue because of the increase in rats and seagulls, especially in the Baronald Area. Cleveden Secondary Parent Council will be informed.
