3. Matters Arising

4. Police Report

PCs Bell and Green are part of the Problem Solving Team for this area dealing with community issues. Leaflets handed out for a service to log property. Parking problems should be referred to Glasgow City Council unless a car is a nuisance or obstruction, then call 101.

5. Elected Members (Cllr Rhodes)

Kelvindale Railway Station - a site visit took place with LES - the railings at the mini-roundabout are always bent and damaged so there is a plan for re-alignment of the junction to help stop accidents causing this. There is no obvious solution to the lack of a footpath over the bridge but the markings will be repainted and the lighting will be looked at. Gullys will be created to help clear flooding and the 'rough' ground around the entrance to the station will be cleared by an environmental task force. Martin has requested information on the ownership of the land around the entrance.

Council Tax - is set to rise and any extra money from funds will be used for cleansing, lighting and pavements.

- Bins left all over the place in back lanes - Martin to follow up
- Possibility of footpath through Gartnavel General Hospital - Health Board matter - Martin to contact them

- Swings and Chute removed from Dawsholm without any consultation - LES say they were removed because they were old and unsafe. There is a review ongoing about suitable replacements and Martin will be in touch about this.

Dorchester Ave. Development – new planning application was filed 20th December 2016, deadline for comments and objections was 20th January 2017. David Gibson (resident) asked if the KCC could 'object' rather than submit 'neutral' comments. The Committee decided to remain 'neutral' and Carol will respond on behalf of KCC. There were 15 letters of objection to the plan.

The traffic assessment is still missing from the plan and Glasgow City Council says the development is short on parking places (17) and therefore have recommended refusing the plan. Martin to request missing transport plan.
