2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:

3. MATTERS ARISING:

M4 Bus - Martin Rhodes has met with SPT; low usage of the M4 (1st Bus) means that it will most likely be withdrawn. This decision will be made in June and a notice of 10 weeks is required before the services stops. SPT has no commitment to subsidised services. Another service (no 94) could possibly be reconfigured. Martin Bartos informed us that he had a seat on SPT.

Dorchester Ave - Planning stalled at the moment until Coal Authority cap mineshaft and check foundations for block closest to the mineshaft; once this happens Planning Permission will probably be passed. Parking issues are ongoing. Martin Bartos did not take part in this discussion as he sits on the Planning Committee.

Noticeboards - one to be put at Kelvindale Railway Station. Martin Rhodes seeing about getting perspex replaced.

4. POLICE REPORT:

30 crimes reported April - May 2017. We have a new boundary but still come under Maryhill Police Station. Police will use a speed gun on Ashburton Road as a speeding deterrent and will try to be more visible in the area. An alternative to Smart Water is 'Immobilise' which records and registers property.

Planning Application for 332 Kelvindale Road - concerned this is for possible non-residential use as there are 9 parking spaces in the application. Residents say noise and dust is a health problem and that the site will be a Surface Mineral Working Yard. Martin will continue investigations and check if the road leading to Kelvindale Court is private. Carol will object of behalf of the Community Council on Health Issues (dust, noise).

Scottish Gas Networks - meeting before end of May regarding the dismantling of the gasometers.
